5. HOT BOX report written (Barry Hensel)

In my opinion, the HotBox is still doing well. Issues are getting out on time, we have had a decent run of articles and reports. Comments are good and supportive. Thus, I believe no changes are needed as far as actual content, format, etc....

However, costs are always an issue. Using the latest issue, Sept 2022, the total cost to print and mail was about \$1175. Doing that 4 times a year, brings us to approx. \$4700 per year.

We have about 302 subscriptions at \$10 each which equals \$3020 income. Other income through the year is from train show ads, totaling approx. \$150; Pike ads at \$400/year (\$15/3 year contract) and hobby shop sales at approx. \$80. That totals \$3650 income/year. Thus... the HotBox for 2022 should be at a deficit of approx. \$950.

Here are my proposals to be voted on today.... or a vote must be taken before October 31, so that any changes that are approved can be advertised in the December issue. And lastly... these prices are negotiable! Feel free to approve as is, or other amounts, but please... keep the increases low!! All changes would take place as of January 1st, 2023 and with the March issue.

- 1) Raise copy price to \$4/issue and subscription to \$13/year (or other amounts agreed on) 2) Add an email direct subscription option at \$8/year (or other amount agreed on)
 - 3) Reduce Hobby Shop copies from 6/store to 5/store

Motion: Pulling 2nd Jones To raise the price of the HOTBOX to \$4/issue and subscription to \$15/year. PASSED
